2020 U-pick Guidelines at Lindberg's Blueberries

The State of Michigan has issued guidance that require us to make some changes in how U-pick is conducted at our farm. As always, of paramount importance is making your visit to our farm both safe and enjoyable!

We ask that if you are feeling sick or displaying any symptoms of COVID-19, please come visit us another day. We will have hand sanitizer available, as well as unisex restroom and and sink if needed.

When you arrive at the farm there will be an outdoor U-pick station, including marked spots to stand so that you and your party can maintain a six-foot distance from other parties.

Another change is that each picking bucket will be sanitized and will include a plastic liner. There will be no personal containers allowed outside of your vehicle and the liner will serve as a take-away container for your picked berries. Each bucket/liner will hold just over six pounds, or about three quarts of berries.

Unfortunately, we will not be able to offer special children's size buckets this year or provide picking ropes. You are welcome to bring your own picking ropes or they can be purchased at the farm for \$1.00 each.

After you decide on the amount of berries that you and your party wish to pick, you will pay and then the farm staff will provide the buckets. The price per bucket is \$10.00. We continue to accept credit card, cash, or check for payment.

You will be directed by farm staff to a picking location. There will be also be signage in the field to assist you to a good picking spot, including a marked path and numbered white pipes that will identify the rows of ripe berries. It is important that you and your party stay together and maintain a minimum of six feet distance in the field from other parties. There is no food, drink, or eating allowed in the field.

When you have finished picking, there will be an identified outdoor table to leave your empty picking bucket. Remove your plastic liner, then take your delicious fruit to your vehicle and you're on your way.
